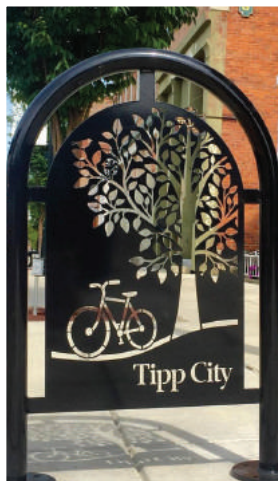
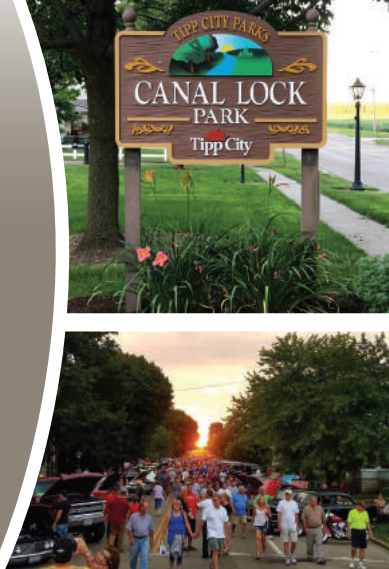

TOP 5: FAMILY FAVORITE STOPS

Five must-see stops on a Miami County family's list. Follow along on this fail-proof adventure!

STOP 1: Johnston Farm & Indian Agency

Learn about the earliest settlers to Southwest Ohio and see how it was living on the Johnston Farm in the early 1800's. You can tour the museum, historic farmhouse, cider house and spring house. Finally, you will enjoy a relaxing ride aboard the General Harrison canal boat on a one-mile restored portion of The Miami-Erie Canal.

STOP 2: Bradford Railroad Museum

The Bradford Railroad Museum takes you on a journey through local railroad history with photos, interactive displays and railroad memorabilia. With a children's area for the little ones, this is one museum the entire family will love.

STOP 3: Barefoot Canoe on the Stillwater River

Enjoy a canoe or kayak trip down the State Scenic Stillwater River. Launch from West Milton and capture the memories as you enjoy the nature that surrounds you.

STOP 4: Brukner Nature Center

The whole family can join in on the fun while watching the birds in the all-season bird vista room, seeing the live native wildlife exhibit, learning in the interactive environmental education center or enjoying a hike through their 6 miles of woodland trails.

STOP 5: WACO

The Miami Valley is filled with captivating aviation history. Learn WACO's story at WACO Air Museum. WACO was the largest manufacturer of civil aircraft in the country in the late 1920's and early 30's. Tour the museum and view the progression of these fabulous WACO planes.

BRADFORD, OHIO RAILROAD MUSEUM >

This newly renovated museum is dedicated to the preservation of Bradford's railroad heritage. The museum has also restored Bradford's Pennsylvania Railroad BF interlocking tower which is located at 501 East Main Street.

BRADFORD RAILROAD MUSEUM / BRADFORD JUNCTION INTERLOCKING TOWER

CIVIL WAR MONUMENT

Intersection of State Routes 48 and 718, Pleasant Hill. Erected in 1895 in the heart of Pleasant Hill to "her fallen heroes who died in defense of the Union and who sleep in unknown graves," it serves as a memorial to those who go to war, and never return.

ELDEAN COVERED BRIDGE

A National Historic Landmark. Corner of North County Road 25-A & Eldean Road, Troy. Built in 1860, it's one of only two covered bridges remaining in the county and is the longest "Long Truss" covered bridge in the nation.

ELIZABETH TOWNSHIP HISTORICAL MUSEUM

5710 East Walnut Grove Road, Troy. 937-339-5209
ElizabethTownshipOhio.com. The museum features a school room with artifacts and photos from the one room schools to Miami East today.

FLETCHER COVERED BRIDGE

Downing Street (one block north of U.S. 36), Fletcher. Dedicated in 1998, the covered bridge is a new look at an old style of bridge design.

FORT PIQUA PLAZA

116 West High Street, Downtown Piqua. 937-773-6753 (Piqua Library). Built in 1891, the Fort Piqua Plaza is a revitalized historic facility that serves as the heart of Piqua featuring the Piqua Public Library, restaurants and shops.

FORT ROWDY MUSEUM

101 East Spring Street, Covington. 937-524-3602
Located in an 1849 schoolhouse, the museum features displays relating to the history of Covington and Newberry Township.

HOBART GALLERY OF WELDING HISTORY

400 Trade Square East, Troy. 937-332-9500
Welding.org. The Hobart Gallery of Welding History welcomes explorers of all ages to learn the history of welding and how it has evolved.

INDIAN CREEK DISTILLERY

7095 Staley Road, New Carlisle. 937-846-1443
StaleyMillFarmAndDistillery.com. This early American artisan farm distillery features the oldest working still in America and offers on-site whiskey sales, tastings, and tours.

MIAMI COUNTY COURTHOUSE

215 West Main Street, Troy. 937-440-5910
Completed in 1888, the courthouse stands as one of the tallest structures in the county, towering 185 feet above the Great Miami River and is fitted with a copper statue of justice with bronze statues in attendance.

THE MUSEUM OF TROY HISTORY

MuseumOfTroyHistory.org. A rich history of Troy, Ohio is housed in the restored pre-Civil War home of John Kitchen where rotating displays depict life in Troy and Miami County between 1850 and 1950.

TREASURE ISLAND

Treasure Island is Troy's newest park dedicated to entertainment and recreation. This historic area along the levy of the Great Miami River is the perfect place for biking and running. An amphitheater plays host to concerts, movies and other fun events. During the warm weather months on Saturday & Sunday, rent kayaks, canoes and all sorts of people powered watercraft.

GETTING OUTDOORS: PEDAL POWER

A great way to spend the day... on bikes! 6.5 miles along the Great Miami River Trail.

START HERE: Lock 9 Park

Bring yourself and your family to this safe and easy access point to the Great Miami River Trail and head south on the paved bikeway.

STOP 1: Robert J. Shook Bikeway Bridge

Take a break at this picture-perfect stop along the way. Continue south to the next great spot!

STOP 2: Twin Arch Reserve

This is a great place to view wildlife! Look out for the renovated, historic Miami-Erie Canal Twin Arches.

STOP 3: Eldean Covered Bridge

Be sure to cross Eldean Road and over this National Historic Landmark. Take note of the craftsmanship that will no doubt take you to another time in Miami County's early history.

STOP 4: El Sombrero Mexican Restaurant

Refreshment awaits you at the final stop, just a few steps off the trail! Park your bikes and eat a hearty meal to replenish you for your next great adventure in Miami County.

A recipe shared by Fulton Farms, a local family farm that was instrumental in the founding of the Troy Strawberry Festival.

INGREDIENTS

Pie Crust:

2 cups Bisquick
1 stick butter or margarine
1 Tbsp. boiling water

Pie Filling:

1 quart fresh Fulton strawberries
2 Tbsp. sugar

1 package (3 oz.) cream cheese
1/3 cup sour cream
1/2 tsp. vanilla
2 Tbsp. water
1/3 cup strawberry jam
2 oz. semisweet chocolate chips
1 Tbsp. butter

DIRECTIONS

Pie Crust: Mix all ingredients together; press into two pie pans. Bake at 400° until light brown.

Pie Filling: Melt together chocolate and butter; while warm, spread evenly over bottom and sides of baked pie shell. Refrigerate.

Beat together cream cheese, sour cream, sugar and vanilla until smooth. Spread evenly in pie shell. Arrange whole strawberries, hulled-side down, over cream filling. Warm jam and water until runny, or use fruit glaze, and spoon over berries. Chill and serve.
