INDIAN CREEK DISTILLERY

This early American artisan farm distillery features the oldest working still in America and offers on-site whiskey sales, tastings, and tours.

DISCOVER MIAMI COUNTY...

Explore the Past: Centuries later we are still able to experience what used to be!

STOP 1: Bradford Railroad Museum

The late 1800's brought the railroad through Bradford. This small village is proud of their railroad heritage and happy to share their love of the rails. Interactive exhibits at the museum and the BF Interlocking Tower invite guests to experience the railroader life.

STOP 2: Johnston Farm & Indian Agency

In the early 1800's, the Miami-Erie canal was an efficient way to transport goods long distances. Right here at Johnston Farm, along a restored section of this important canal system, you can still hop aboard the General Harrison canal boat and take a journey through history.

STOP 3: Historic WACO Field & Learning Center

Weaver Aircraft Company was the largest manufacturer of civil aircraft in the US in the late 1920's and early 30's. Today, at this historic field you can take a flight and soar through the skies in one of these aviation marvels.

STOP 4: Indian Creek Distillery

Famous for quality rye whiskey in the 1800's, prohibition in 1920 brought distillery production to a screeching halt. The distillery has been resurrected by 6th generation descendants who are proud to share the history and the spirits made from those original copper stills.

STOP 5: Troy-Hayner Cultural Center

This former home of Mary Jane Hayner, built in 1914, has housed the Troy Public Library and now serves as the arts and culture center of Miami County. Take classes in arts, dance, music and more, wander through the mansion viewing the latest exhibit, or enjoy one of the many community concerts which are free and open to the public.

STOP 6: Overfield Tavern Museum

1808 was a time when the small settlement of Troy Ohio was on the great frontier. This tavern was a gathering place for social and government purposes. The two-story Federal style square-hewn log building has survived as the oldest building in Troy. Take a tour to see its collections or attend one of the many events throughout the year.

DID YOU KNOW? *fun facts!*

In June of 1974, the first U.P.C. scanner was installed at a Marsh's supermarket in Troy. The first product to have a barcode was Wrigley's Gum.



HOMEGROWN *heritage*

Wherever you are in Miami County, you're sure to stumble on one of these beautiful barns.

Decorating the scenic landscape are true folk art renditions of traditional quilt squares, hand painted on barns throughout the county. This colorful array of barn quilts connects the picturesque countryside with our lovely historic downtown communities while celebrating the unique rural and agricultural experience in our area. Enjoy the beauty and simple elegance of the land as you make your way from town to town.

The Barn Quilts can be viewed up close by driving into the farm lanes or driveways, where some of the owners may even personally welcome their visitors. As an added bonus, many of the farms have a wide assortment of horses, cows, goats, sheep, llamas, donkeys, roosters, and more – all waiting to greet you in their own special way.

You'll want to grab your camera and pick the perfect day whether it be during a Fall color explosion, Spring's burst of new flowers, Summer's brilliant sunshine, or even the cool, crisp air of Winter. It's always a picturesque scene!

BRADFORD OHIO RAILROAD MUSEUM

This newly renovated museum is dedicated to the preservation of Bradford's railroad heritage. The museum has also restored Bradford's Pennsylvania Railroad BF Interlocking Tower which is located at 501 East Main Street.

CIVIL WAR MONUMENT

Erected in 1895 in the heart of Pleasant Hill to "her fallen heroes who died in defense of the Union and who sleep in unknown graves," it serves as a memorial to those who go to war, and never return.

FORT PIQUA PLAZA BANQUET CENTER

Built in 1891, the Fort Piqua Plaza has been an icon of history in Piqua for nearly 130 years. This hotel played host to many prominent people including Teddy Roosevelt and William Howard Taft who both spoke from its balcony during their campaign tours in 1912. This beautiful Late-Victorian style building is now home to the Piqua Public Library, restaurants and a grand banquet center.

BRADFORD RAILROAD MUSEUM / BRADFORD JUNCTION INTERLOCKING TOWER
200 North Miami Avenue, Bradford 937-552-2196

CIVIL WAR MONUMENT
Location: Intersection of State Routes 48 and 718, Pleasant Hill. Erected in 1895 in the heart of Pleasant Hill to "her fallen heroes who died in defense of the Union and who sleep in unknown graves," it serves as a memorial to those who go to war, and never return.

ELDEAN COVERED BRIDGE
A National Historic Landmark
Corner of North County Road 25-A & Eldean Road, Troy. Built in 1860, it's one of only two covered bridges remaining in the county and is the longest "Long Truss" covered bridge in the nation.

ELIZABETH TOWNSHIP HISTORICAL MUSEUM
5710 East Walnut Grove Road, Troy 937-339-5209
ElizabethTownshipOhio.com. The museum features a school room with artifacts and photos from the one room schools to Miami East today.

FLETCHER COVERED BRIDGE
Downing Street (one block north of U.S. 36), Fletcher. Dedicated in 1998, the covered bridge is a new look at an old style of bridge design.

FORT PIQUA PLAZA
116 West High Street, Downtown Piqua 937-773-6753 (Piqua Library). Built in 1891, the Fort Piqua Plaza is a revitalized historic facility that serves as the heart of Piqua featuring the Piqua Public Library, restaurants and shops.

FORT ROWDY MUSEUM
101 East Spring Street, Covington 937-524-3602
Located in an 1849 schoolhouse, the museum features displays relating to the history of Covington and Newberry Township.

HOBART GALLERY OF WELDING HISTORY
400 Trade Square East, Troy 937-332-9500
Welding.org. The Hobart Gallery of Welding History welcomes explorers of all ages to learn the history of welding and how it has evolved.

INDIAN CREEK DISTILLERY
7095 Staley Road, New Carlisle 937-846-1443
IndianCreekDistillery.com. This early American artisan farm distillery features the oldest working still in America and offers on-site whiskey sales, tastings, and tours.

JOHNSTON FARM AND INDIAN AGENCY

MIAMI COUNTY COURTHOUSE
215 West Main Street, Troy 937-440-5910
Completed in 1888, the courthouse stands as one of the tallest structures in the county, towering 185 feet above the Great Miami River and is fitted with a copper statue of justice with bronze statues in attendance.

THE MIAMI VALLEY VETERANS MUSEUM

Dedicated to honoring, preserving and perpetuating the memory and dignity of the men and women who have served in the U. S. Armed Forces, Coast Guard, and Wartime Merchant Marines.

THE MUSEUM OF TROY HISTORY

MuseumOfTroyHistory.org. A rich history of Troy, Ohio is housed in the restored pre-Civil War home of John Kitchen where rotating displays depict life in Troy and Miami County between 1850 and 1950.

OVERFIELD TAVERN MUSEUM

OverfieldTavernMuseum.com. Built as a tavern by Benjamin Overfield between 1803-1808, this log constructed building houses period room settings that display early American culture as it existed on the frontier, west of the Allegheny.

PLEASANT HILL HISTORY CENTER

PleasantHillHistoryCenter.com. The center features historical displays of merchants, schools, and local people from Pleasant Hill and Newton Township.

TIPPECANOE HISTORICAL MUSEUM

This museum showcases the history, companies, and artifacts relevant to Tipp City, the Miami and Erie Canal, Chaffee Opera House, and the Society's Oral History Project.

TROY-HAYNER CULTURAL CENTER

TroyHayner.org. The Hayner mansion was built in 1914 by Mary Jane Hayner, whose husband owned the Hayner Distillery Company and now serves as the arts and cultural center of the community.

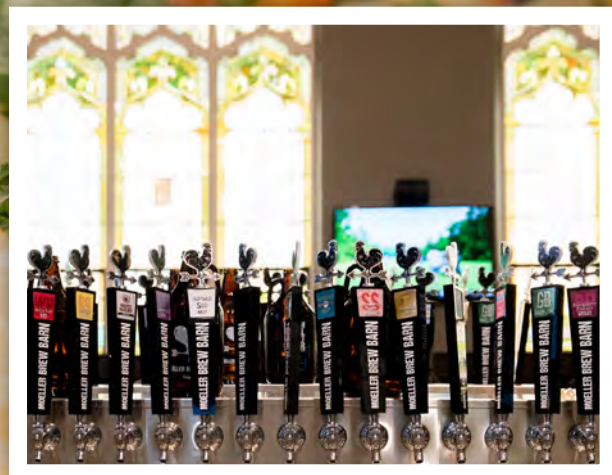

STOP 2: Indian Creek Distillery

Sample a unique early American frontier whiskey that is distilled in the same copper pot stills from almost 200 years ago. Learn the history of the Staley Mill Farm and distillery in their tasting room, featuring historic photos and artifacts dating back to the early 1800s.

STOP 3: Old Mason Winery

Relax in the brick tasting room or on the patio overlooking the vineyard. Sip on one of their handcrafted wines or try a variety with their wine flights.

STOP 4: Twenty One Barrels Cidery & Winery

Explore this brand new cidery and winery nestled on 20 acres of land in the country. Help yourself to a glass of wine or hard cider as you stroll among the vines.

STOP 5: Chaffee's Brewhouse

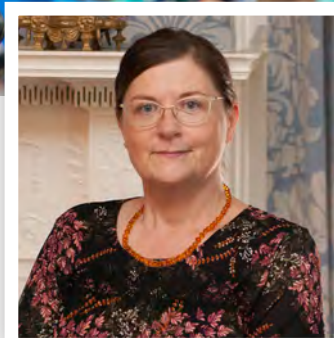

HOMEGROWN *bike trails*

The Troy Mountain Bike Area, TMBA, is a series of mountain bike/fat bike trails located on the west side of Duke Park for the recreational benefit of people in the Troy and surrounding areas. It was built in 2017 by local volunteers organized as the Mayor's Cycling Committee through a grant from The Troy Foundation and is supported by the Troy Parks Department. TMBA has approximately 8 miles of trail ranging from beginner to intermediate with little elevation change, including sections of singletrack that are mostly root and rock free for those just learning.



WACO Biplane Ride

ELDEAN COVERED BRIDGE

Eldean Bridge, built in 1860, is one of only two covered bridges in Miami County. It was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1975 and was designated a National Historic Landmark in 2016.

CHARLESTON FALLS NATURE PRESERVE

Charleston Falls Preserve is the most visited Park District property in Miami County with over 216 acres of prairie and forest. The most unusual feature of this preserve is the 37' waterfall.

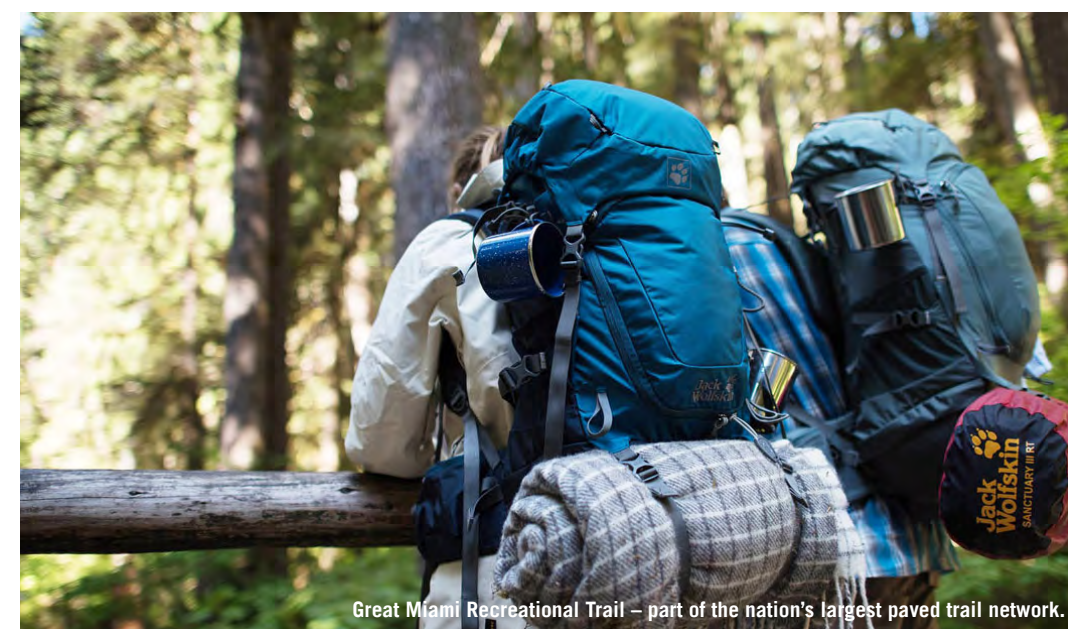

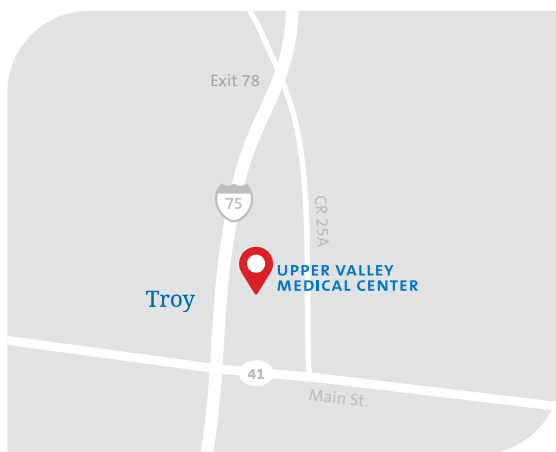

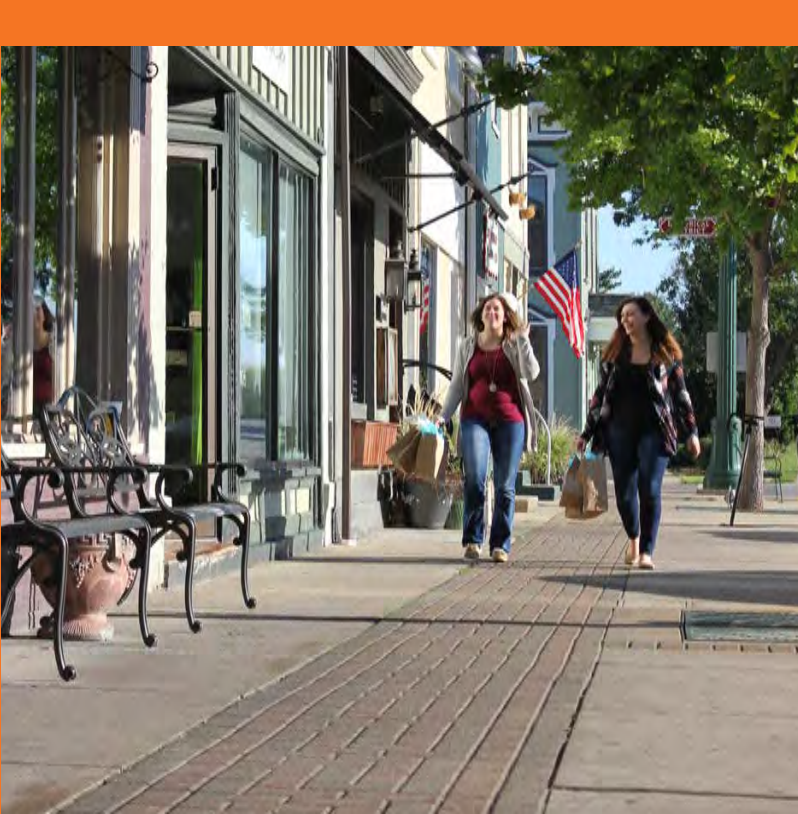
