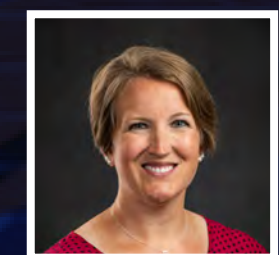

Get Out There

Weaver Aircraft Company (WACO) was the largest manufacturer of civil aircraft in the US in the late 1920's and early 30's. Today, at this historic field, you can take a flight and soar through the skies in one of these aviation marvels.

FAMILY FRIENDLY ATTRACTIONS

Miami County is a story of captivating history and early innovations. These educational attractions make learning fun for adults and kids alike.

Bradford Ohio Railroad Museum and BF Interlocking Tower

Proud of its railroad history, Bradford named their mascot after the men who built the town. Railroad enthusiasts of all ages will love the exhibits, memorabilia, and interactive displays as well as the children's area and new HOB0 exhibit.

Brukner Nature Center

Families will love the great outdoors at Brukner Nature Center. Animals and outdoor spaces are abundant here as you hike the trails, watch the birds, pet the turtles, see the wildlife, and listen to the frogs croaking by the pond.

Johnston Farm & Indian Agency

Experience a different kind of boat ride on the General Harrison at Johnston Farm. Tour the museum, historic Johnston home, cider house, and spring house. Costumed interpreters and craft demonstrators provide for a realistic visit to the first half of the 19th century.

WACO Air Museum

At WACO, your family can visit the hangars filled with vintage WACO aircraft and historic aviation artifacts. Experience the "Golden Age of Aviation" by watching clips of the CG4A glider in action in the glider theater or practice your flying skills in the WACO simulator.

COUNTY COURTHOUSE

Construction of the Miami County Courthouse was completed in 1888. It was designed by architect Joseph Yost of Columbus, Ohio.

The statue of Lady Justice at the top of the courthouse dome carries the sword of truth and scales of justice... always balanced. At the front of the courthouse are the statues that represent education. The statue facing west represents agriculture and carries a scythe and a bundle of wheat. Transportation looks east and carries a small locomotive. Industry to the north holds a wrench and is standing by a lathe.

The Miami County Courthouse was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1975.

The block columns in the fountain on the courthouse plaza are columns from the old 1854 jail that was located at the corner of West Main and Plum Street.

Overfield Tavern Museum ▼

1808 was a time when the small settlement of Troy, Ohio was on the great frontier. This tavern was a gathering place for social and government purposes. The two-story Federal style square-hewn log building has survived as the oldest building in Troy.

155 years ago, Lewis Hayner opened a small distillery on the banks of the Miami River in Troy, Ohio. Hayner Distilling grew into one of the largest distilleries in Ohio and the largest mail order whiskey business in America. Hayner Distilling closed in 1920 with prohibition. 100 years later, Hayner Distilling has been reborn! From a few surviving bottles, the original whiskey was analyzed and a blend complimentary to the original Hayner was created. More information can be found at www.haynerdistilling.com.

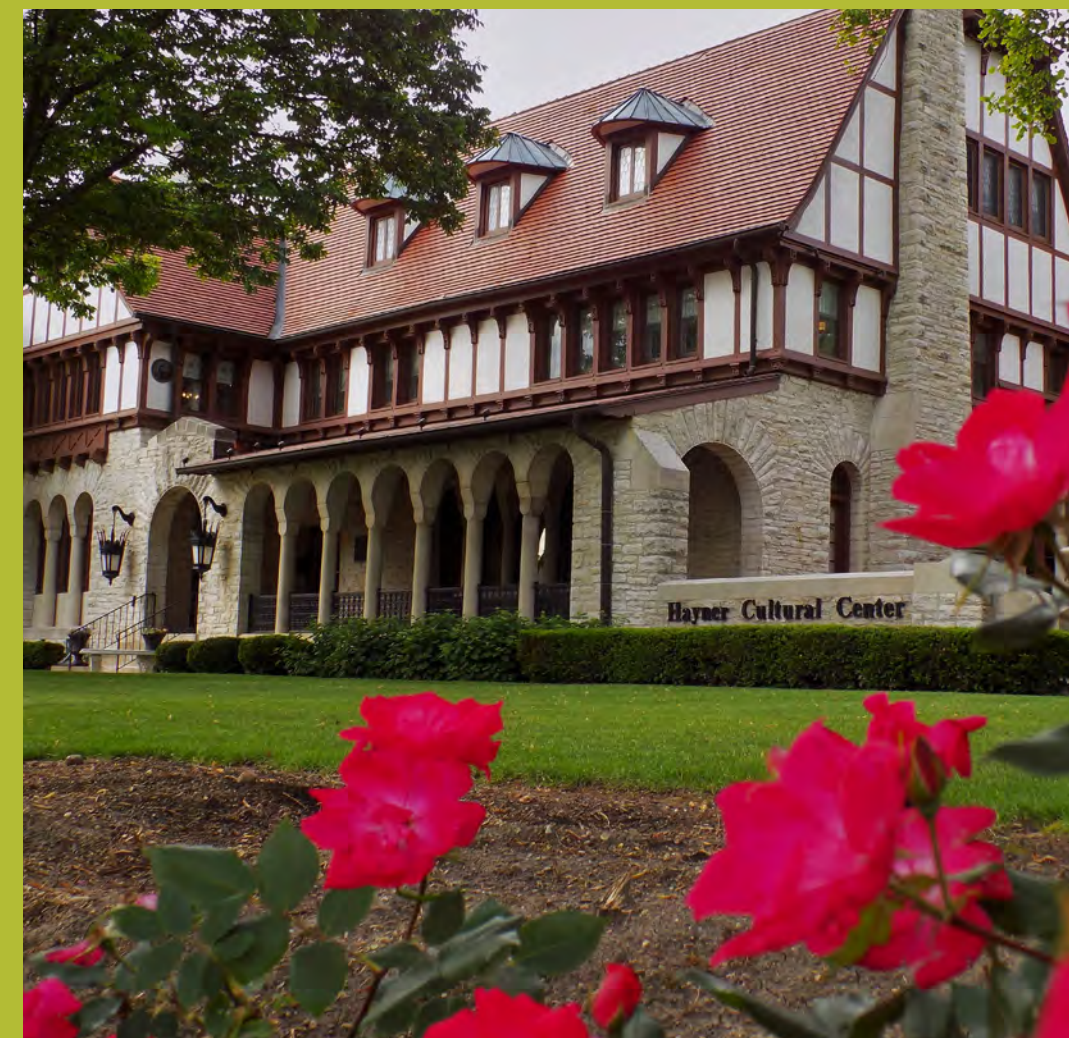


Johnston Farm General Harrison ▲

In the early 1800's, The Miami-Erie canal was an efficient way to transport goods. Here at Johnston Farm, along a restored section of this canal system, you can still hop aboard the General Harrison canal boat and take a journey through history.

Troy Hayner Cultural Center ▼

This former home of Mary Jane Hayner, built in 1914, has housed the Troy Public Library and now serves as the arts and culture center of Miami County. Take classes in arts, dance and more or wander through the mansion viewing the latest exhibit.



Bradford Ohio Railroad Museum ►

The late 1800's brought the railroad to Bradford. This small village is proud of their heritage and happy to share their love of the rails. Interactive exhibits at the museum and BF Interlocking Tower invite guests to experience the railroader life.

Serving a seven-county area, the Miami Valley Veterans Museum is a long-term repository for artifacts, photos, over 200 veterans interviews in their Research/Multi-Media Center and other objects of significance to local veterans and their families.

CIVIL WAR MONUMENT
Intersection of State Routes 48 and 718, Pleasant Hill
Erected in 1895 in the heart of Pleasant Hill to "her fallen heroes who died in defense of the Union and who sleep in unknown graves," it serves as a memorial to those who go to war, and never return.

ELDEAN COVERED BRIDGE
A National Historic Landmark
Corner of N. County Road 25-A & Eldean Road, Troy
Built in 1860, it's one of only two covered bridges remaining in the county and is the longest "Long Truss" covered bridge in the nation.

The barn quilts can be viewed up close by driving into the farm lanes or driveways, where some of the owners may even personally welcome their visitors. Downtown Troy has some fabulous murals that would make a perfect backdrop. A mural located at **Prouty Plaza** using different colors and shapes makes for a fun and funky background. And the mural in the parking lot of the Troy Rec portrays a black and white image of a canal boat and downtown scenery.

On the corner of East High and North Main in downtown Piqua, you'll find a tall mural showcasing the Miami and Erie Canal and early settlers of Piqua. Stand on **Veterans Memorial Way** to get the right angle to include the entire mural in your photo.

Grab an ice cream and take a cute photo sitting on the bench in front of the **Gem City Ice Cream** mural located on the corner of North Second and East Main in downtown Tipp City. 

Water lovers can schedule river trips through Adventures on the Great Miami in Tipp City and Barefoot Canoe Rentals in West Milton. So many adventures await you!

CYCLING

Miami County is a great place for biking enthusiasts to visit.

Miami County is home to a section of the **Great Miami Recreational Trail** which is part of the largest paved trail network in the country. Much of this trail runs alongside the 99-mile stretch of the **Great Miami Riverway** which starts in Sidney and ends in Hamilton. While cycling, be sure to stop at some of the amazing and unique communities along the Great Miami Riverway. Miami County, in particular, has some fantastic local shopping and restaurants you'll want to take some time to explore.

The **Tour de Donut Bicycle Challenge** takes place annually the weekend prior to Labor Day weekend. This event values your ability to eat donuts as much as your riding pace. Riders have the option to choose between four courses and visits donut stops along the way to eat as many donuts as they can. At the end, the donut tallies will be counted, and each donut deducts five minutes off your total time. If you like cycling - and you like donuts - this event is for you!

Also happening during the summer of 2022 is The **Great Ohio Bicycle Adventure**, also known as GOBA. In this event, cyclists will be traveling throughout Western Ohio, starting in Sidney, making their way through Wapakoneta and Versailles, having their final stop in Troy to loop back around to Sidney again. This week-long event is always a hit and encourages new and veteran riders to participate.

And, for all of you trail riders, make sure you check out the **Troy Mountain Bike Area**, TMBA, which is a series of mountain bike/fat bike trails located on the west side of Duke Park. It was built in 2017 by local volunteers and provides approximately 8 miles of trail ranging from beginner to intermediate. TMBA prides itself in being a family-friendly mountain biking destination. The trails are relatively smooth with limited obstacles and features.

Grab your bike and participate in any of the cycling events happening in our area or cruise along the many paths we have year-round.



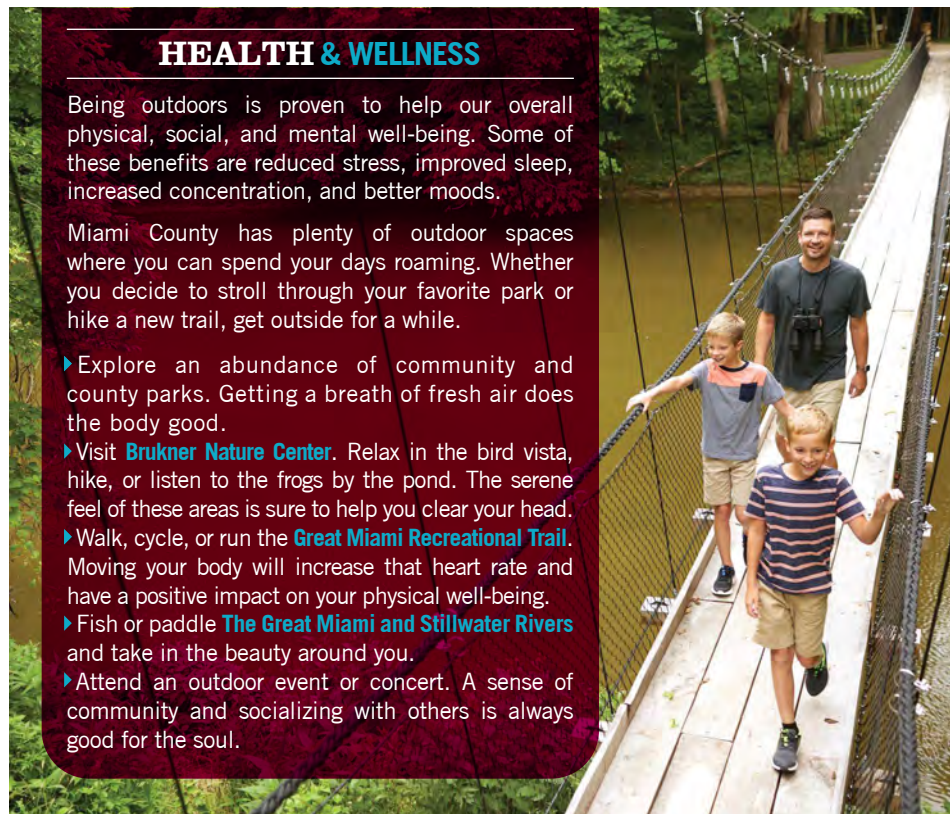

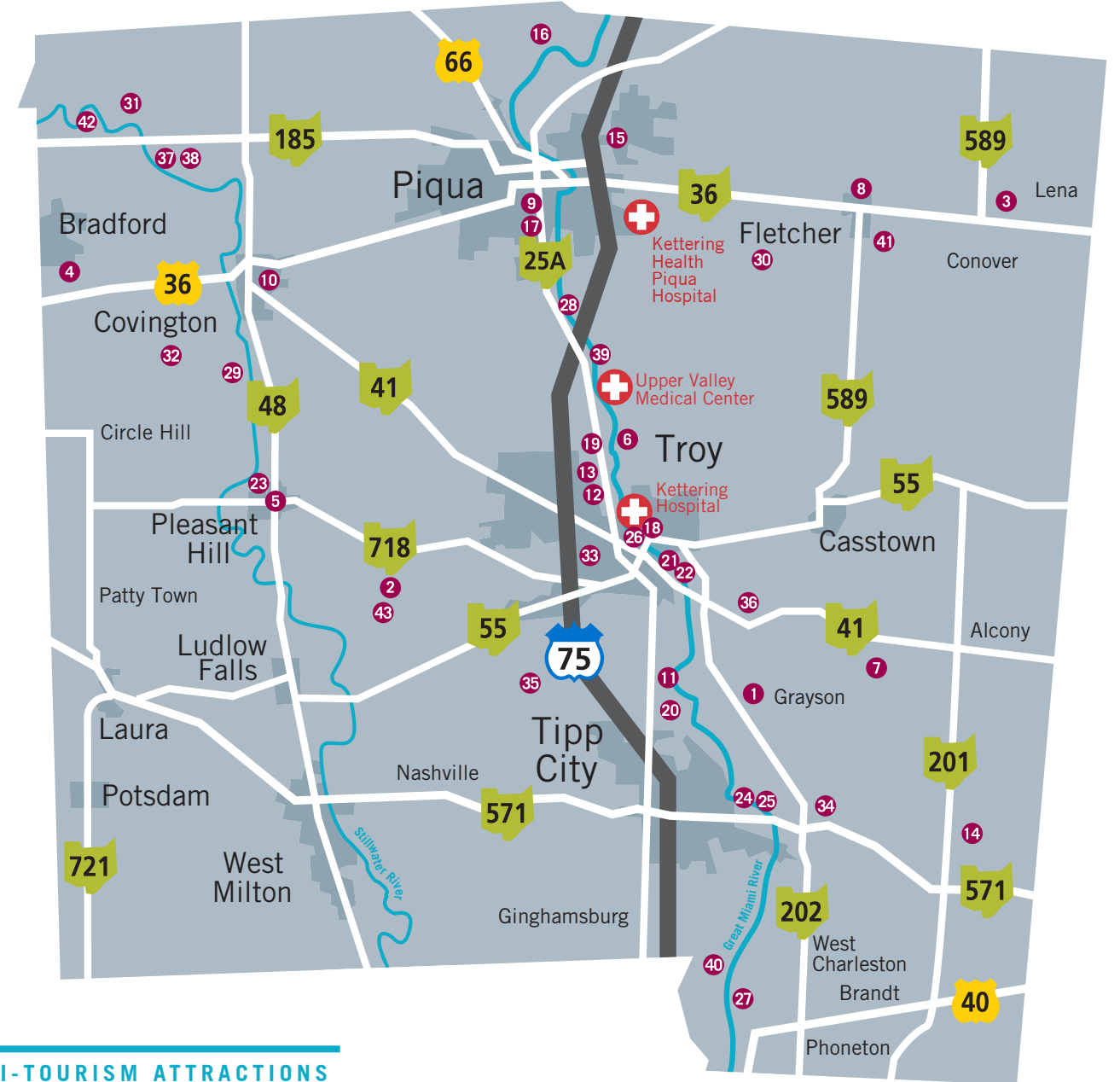
