MIAMI COUNTY IS RICH IN TRANSPORTATION HISTORY!

Miami County history tells a story of innovation and expansion. Beginning with the construction of the Miami and Erie Canal from 1825-1845 and the introduction of the railroad to the area in 1857 to biplanes in the early 1900's and the release of the original Ford Mustang in 1964, Miami County is proud of its history and heritage and the people who have impacted our forward progress.

Johnston Farm & Indian Agency

Experience a different kind of boat ride on the General Harrison at Johnston Farm. The General Harrison is

one of a handful of canal boats in Ohio still drawn, as it was done almost two centuries ago, by a team of mules. On a visit to Johnston Farm, guests will enjoy a ride on this replica 70-foot-long canal boat which at one time was used to haul passengers and cargo along the Miami and Erie Canal. Costumed guides provide an authentic and memorable experience back in time.

Bradford Ohio Railroad Museum and BF Interlocking Tower

The railroad came to Bradford in 1857 when the first train reached the end of the railhead at the Miami/Darke County line. Being an important junction between connecting rail terminals, most trains passing

through Bradford changed crews here. Bradford became known as a "railroad town" and the railroad was seen as the dominant industry for many years. This small community in western Miami County is proud of their railroad heritage and celebrates it still to this day.

WACO Air Museum

The Weaver Aircraft Company (WACO) was the largest manufacturer of civil aircraft in the US in the late 1920's and early 1930's. Today, at this historic field and museum, you can take a flight in WACO's biplane, "Sunny", to see beautiful Miami County from the sky. Sunny was given the US identification number N820WF to correspond with the elevation of 820 feet above sea level at WACO field and was donated to the WACO Air Museum in 2016 by the Jaffe family from Texas.

Gale Halderman Museum

Gale Halderman, born and raised in Tipp City, was the designer of the original Ford Mustang and worked for Ford Motor Company for over 40 years. A visit to the Halderman Barn Museum is a trip through 40 years of Mustang history. You will be awed as you peruse wall-to-wall, floor-to-ceiling exhibits including historical photos, original drawings, posters, awards, and an extensive collection of other memorabilia dedicated to this iconic automobile.

Make plans today to visit these museums to learn about the transportation history of Miami County and its impact on the county, the region, the country, and the world.

Miami Valley Veterans Museum ▾

Serving a seven-county area, the Miami Valley Veterans Museum is a long-term repository for artifacts, photos, over 200 veterans interviews in their Research/Multi-Media Center and other objects of significance to local veterans and their families.



Miami County Courthouse ▸

Construction of the Miami County Courthouse was completed in 1888 and was designed by architect Joseph Yost of Columbus, Ohio. The Miami County Courthouse was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1975.

Johnston Farm ▸

John Johnston’s 1815, three-story Federal farmhouse included a winter kitchen and was a unique structure on the Ohio frontier, acting both as a family home and the only Federal Indian Agency in the state. Restorations to the Johnston Home were completed in 2022.



Troy Hayner Cultural Center ▾

This former home of Mary Jane Hayner, built in 1914, has housed the Troy Public Library and now serves as the arts and culture center of Miami County. Take classes in arts, dance and more or wander through the mansion viewing the latest exhibit.

Eldean Bridge ▴

Take a drive through Eldean Bridge, the longest “Long Truss” covered bridge in the country. It was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1975 and was designated a National Historic Landmark in 2016.



Overfield Tavern Museum ▴

1808 was a time when the small settlement of Troy, Ohio was on the great frontier. This tavern was a gathering place for social and government purposes. The two-story Federal style square-hewn log building has survived as the oldest building in Troy.

▴ **Indian Creek Distillery**

A “true sip of history”, Indian Creek Distillery whiskeys are uniquely small batch where art and science and heritage combine to produce a spirit like no other. Award winning, their Legendary Ohio Frontier Whiskeys are created with a passionate dedication to authenticity – slowly and thoughtfully crafted.

CIVIL WAR MONUMENT
Intersection of State Routes 48 and 718, Pleasant Hill
Erected in 1895 in the heart of Pleasant Hill to “her fallen heroes who died in defense of the Union and who sleep in unknown graves,” it serves as a memorial to those who go to war, and never return.

ELDEAN COVERED BRIDGE
A National Historic Landmark
Corner of N. County Road 25-A & Eldean Road, Troy
Built in 1860, it’s one of only two covered bridges remaining in the county and is the longest “Long Truss” covered bridge in the nation.

Dedicated in 1998, the covered bridge is a new look at an old style of bridge design.

This colorful array of barn quilts connects the picturesque countryside with our lovely historic downtown communities while celebrating the unique rural and agricultural experience in our area. Enjoy the beauty and simple elegance of the land as you make your way from town to town.

The barn quilts can be viewed up close by driving into the farm lanes or driveways, where some of the owners may even personally welcome their visitors. As an added bonus, many of the farms have a wide assortment of horses, cows, goats, sheep, llamas, donkeys, roosters, and more – all waiting to greet you in their own special way.

You'll want to grab your camera and pick the perfect day whether it be during a Fall color explosion, Spring's burst of new flowers, Summer's brilliant sunshine, or even the cool, crisp Winter air. It's always a picturesque scene!

THE DESIGNATED OUTDOOR REFRESHMENT AREA, DORA

The DORA, Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area, gives you the opportunity to have a drink and browse some of your favorite shops in Tipp City, Troy, and Piqua. Come and enjoy a drink and time with friends in three of our beautiful downtown communities.

Some general rules for DORA participants include, that you must be at least 21 years of age or older to participate and purchase alcohol. You cannot bring outside beverages or beverages bought at one establishment to another alcohol selling establishment. All beverages being consumed must be in a DORA-approved cup within the boundaries of the DORA. Downtown businesses are given the

option to participate in DORA, the green sign in the window means you may bring your drink in, the red sign means you may not and the cup must be empty or disposed of before entering. Stay within the DORA boundaries and dispose of all trash properly. Pick up your DORA cup at participating establishments and remember to enjoy the DORA responsibly.

THE MAYFLOWER: FROM THEATER TO DISTILLERY

The Mayflower Theatre, a historic building in downtown Troy, was built in 1928 by C.F. Pfister of the Troy Amusement Company. The building's vaudeville stage and Baldwin organ joined forces to host live theatrical and musical performances. In more recent years, The Mayflower transitioned into a traditional movie theater and mixed-media arts center.

In 2023, the A.M. Scott Distillery team, a Troy-based hospitality, retail and restaurant company, announced plans for new life for this iconic building on the Public Square. The building is also well-known for its colorful mural on the east side, featuring work by the late Aka Peremya.

Soon, 9 West Main Street will be a mixed-use space, home to craft cocktails, food, live entertainment, a retail space and rooftop experience. **Provisions Co.**, a Troy-based retail shop will be housed in the southwest portion of the building where The Sweet Shop once welcomed visitors, while **The Mayflower by A.M. Scott Distillery** entrance will be in the southwest corner, where the original theater entrance welcomed movie-goers.

Renovations are on-going with hopes of fully opening the building by late fall of 2023.

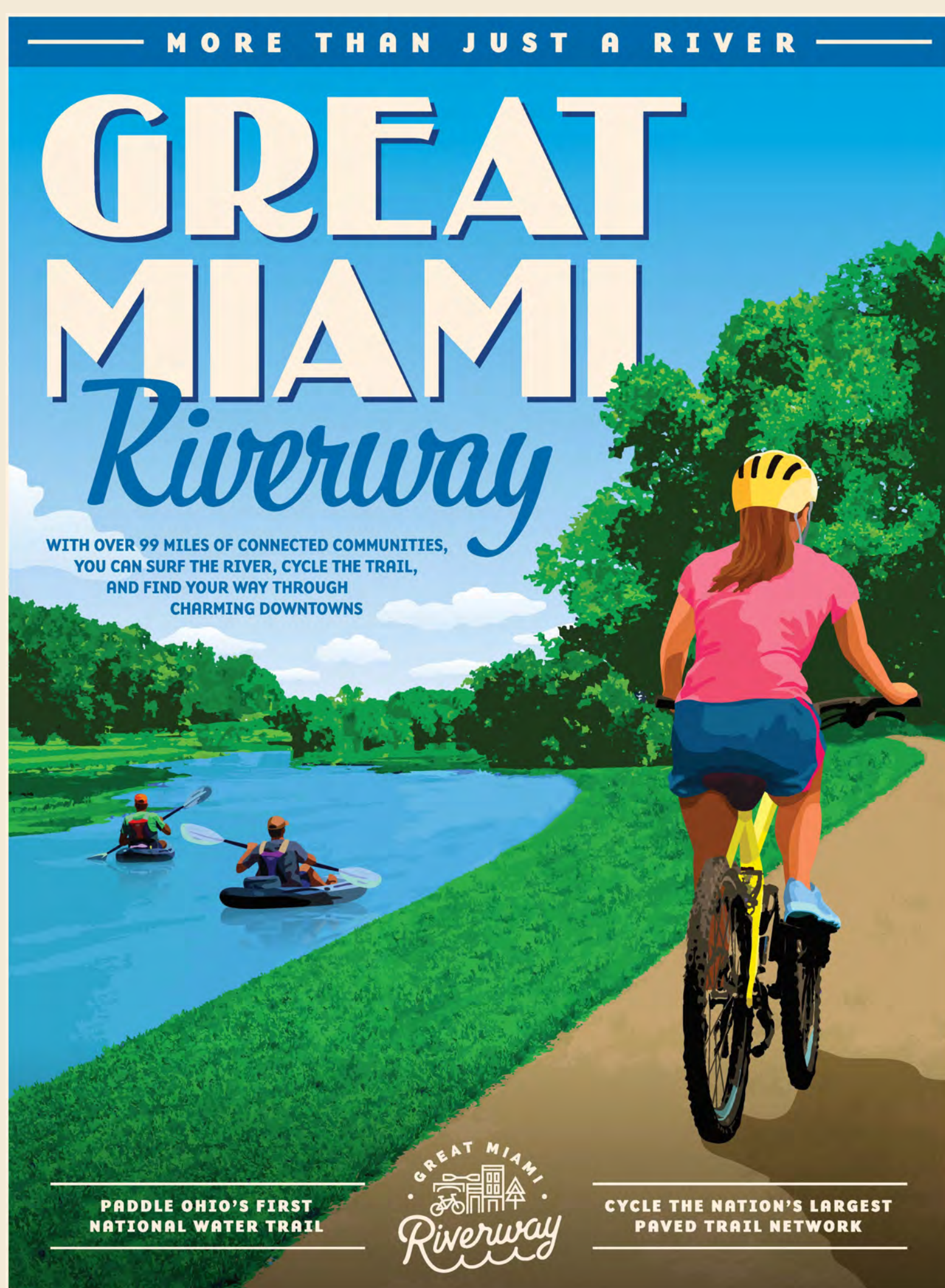

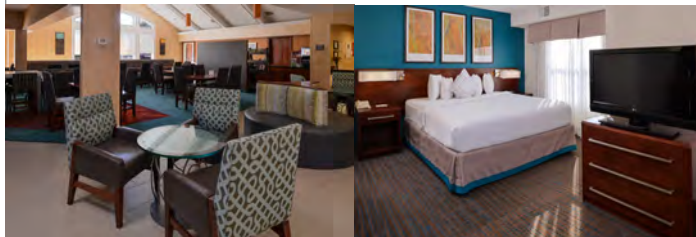

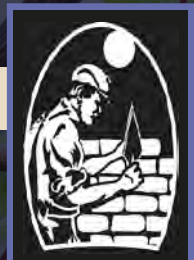

On April 8, 2024, Miami County residents and visitors will be able to experience something that won't happen in Ohio again until 2099 – a total solar eclipse. A total solar eclipse occurs when the Moon passes between the Sun and Earth, completely blocking the Sun. The last one visible in Ohio occurred in 1806 so this is a very rare and once-in-a-lifetime event.

Miami County is in the path of totality for the 2024 eclipse and is planning a variety of events and activities throughout the area for viewers to take part

in during the days leading up to and following this eclipse. Remember that the only safe way to look directly at the eclipsed sun without damaging the eyes is through special eclipse glasses (AAS approved). A limited quantity of glasses will be available throughout Miami County during eclipse events.

Information about viewing areas, events, lodging, and other things to do in the area is available at MiamiCountySolarEclipse.com. Check back frequently because details will be added as they become available.

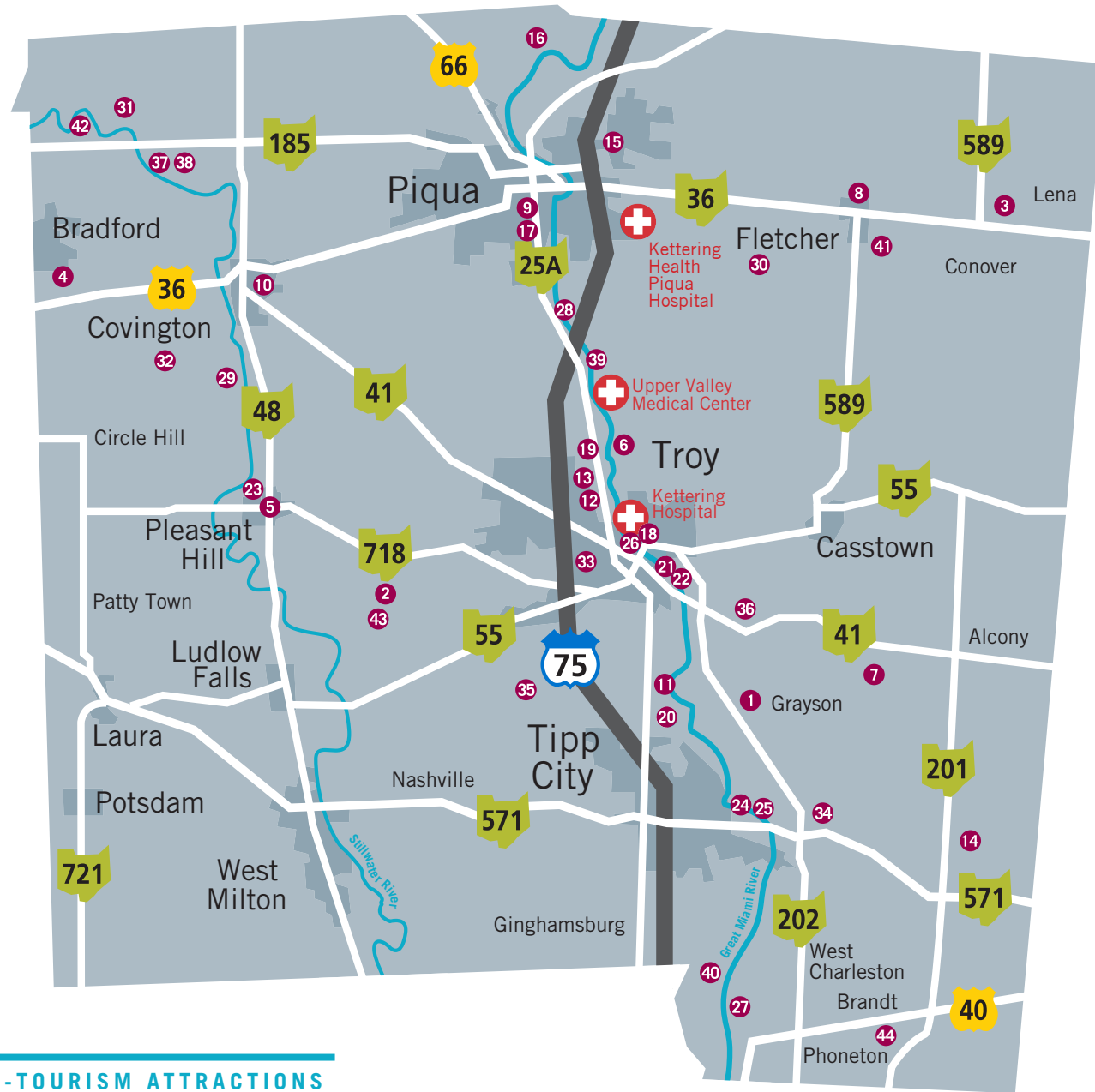
