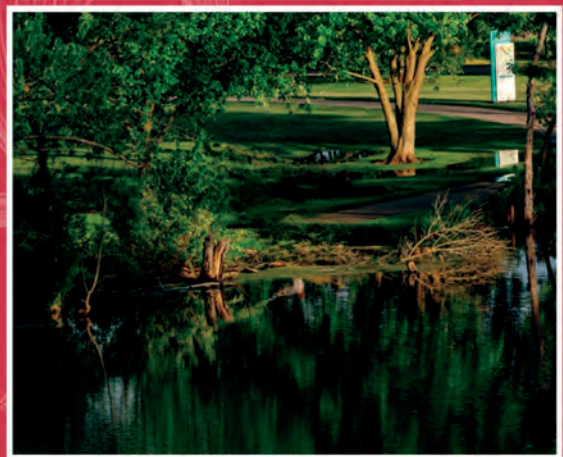
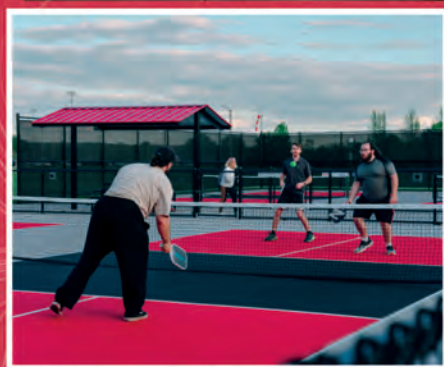

TWO MUSEUMS, ONE HISTORIC EXPERIENCE



Three beloved Miami County entities have come together to create something even stronger for the future. The neighboring **Overfield Tavern Museum** and **Museum of Troy History** have officially merged and will now operate under The Troy Historical Society.

With more than 60 years of preserving local stories, the Troy Historical Society is building on its legacy with a renewed vision—creating a more engaging and seamless way for residents and visitors to explore Troy and Miami County's past. This exciting partnership offers an enriched experience for curious travelers, history enthusiasts, and families alike.

Through its continued focus on research and genealogy, the Society's expanded collection will help

both museums tell complementary chapters of Troy's story. The Overfield Tavern Museum—Ohio's oldest log tavern listed on the National Register of Historic Places—explores life before the Miami and Erie Canal arrived in 1837, along with the story of tavern keeper Benjamin Overfield. Meanwhile, the Museum of Troy History highlights the city's social, industrial, and governmental development from the mid-19th through the mid-20th century.

Together, these museums create a dynamic journey through time. We invite you to explore, discover, and connect with the stories, places, and people that make Miami County truly Home.Grown.Great.

LOCAL DISTILLERIES COLLAB ON TWO EPIC BOURBONS

Two historic distilleries, two distinct blends, coming together for one limited-edition series. The Miami County Distillery Series is an exciting collaboration between Miami County's historic distilleries, **Indian Creek Distillery** (Est. 1820) and **Hayner Distilling Co.** (Est. 1866).

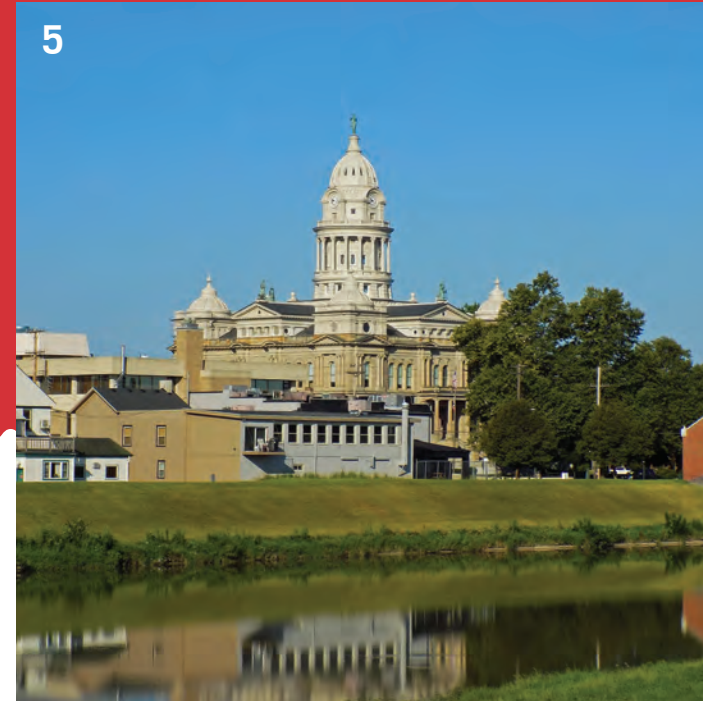
Hayner Distilling Company was originally founded in 1866 and in just over 50 years became one of the largest distilleries in Ohio and largest mail order whiskey business in the country. Due to prohibition, Hayner closed their doors in the 1920s, but was brought back to life almost 100 years later, in 2021. Now Hayner Distilling offers a variety of spirits like whiskey, rye, and bourbons, and even new items like flavored vodka and gin.

History is alive and well at Indian Creek Distillery. Authentic and true to the spirit of the historic Staley Mill Farm, this 6th generation distillery is crafting old fashioned frontier whiskey using the same recipe and copper pot stills that were used almost 200 years ago. Come taste early American whiskey and shop for spirits, flasks, whiskey accessories, and more. Their space also features historic photos and artifacts, some dating back to the early 1800s when Staley's whiskey-making legacy began. This is a great stop for both whiskey and history lovers.

For this limited-edition series, each distillery has handcrafted a one-of-a-kind bourbon blend, with 50% of the bourbon coming from each distillery. Revival Bourbon is available at Hayner Distilling, and Legacy Bourbon can be found at Indian Creek Distillery. Only 250 bottles of each blend were produced for the first series so, once they're gone, they're gone for good. Bottles are \$90 plus tax and will be available exclusively at each distillery, go get yours today!

1 BRADFORD RAILROAD MUSEUM AND BF INTERLOCKING TOWER

Take a trip back in time at the Bradford Railroad Museum. Adults and children alike will enjoy learning about Miami County's railroad history and its impact in the late 1800s and early 1900s. Your visit also includes Bradford's restored Pennsylvania Railroad BF Interlocking Tower, located just down the street, with additional exhibits.

2 ELDEAN BRIDGE

Built in 1860, it's one of only two covered bridges remaining in the county and is the longest "Long Truss" covered bridge in the country spanning 224 feet. Its historical significance earned it a spot on the National Register of Historic Places in 1975, and in 2016, it was further honored as a national Historic Landmark. You can walk or drive across Eldean Bridge.

3 HALDERMAN BARN MUSEUM

Gale Halderman was the designer of the original Ford Mustang. If you are a Mustang (car) enthusiast or just love history, a stop at the Halderman Museum is a must. Gale passed away in 2020 at the age of 87, but his stories live on through his personal collection of items from his life and career at the Ford Motor Company. Tours by appointment only.

4 JOHNSTON FARM & INDIAN AGENCY

Johnston Farm & Indian Agency celebrates 2,000 years of Ohio history, from prehistoric Native Americans to the canal era, honoring John Johnston—farmer, public official, and U.S. Indian Agent (1812–1829). Visitors can explore the museum, Johnston's home, and ride The General Harrison, a 70-foot replica canal boat once used to haul passengers and cargo along the Miami-Erie Canal. Costumed guides throughout the farm and boat bring the past to life.

5 MIAMI COUNTY COURTHOUSE

Completed in 1888, the courthouse stands as one of the tallest structures in the county, towering 185 feet above the Great Miami River and is fitted with a copper statue of Lady Justice with bronze statues in attendance. The Courthouse was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1975.

6 MIAMI VALLEY VETERANS MUSEUM

Serving a seven-county area, the five-acre Miami Valley Veterans Museum is a long-term repository for artifacts, photos, over 250 veterans' interviews in their Research/Multimedia Center and other objects of significance to veterans and their families. Museum exhibits reflect time periods from 1745 to the present day and focus on all branches of the military.

7 WACO EDUCATION CENTER & AIR MUSEUM

The Weaver Aircraft Company (WACO) was the largest manufacturer of civil aircraft in the U.S. in the late 1920's and early 1930's. Today, at this historic field and museum, you can view vintage WACO aircraft and historic aviation artifacts. With a mission to educate and inspire students and adults who have a passion for flying, there are a variety of STEM programs offered at WACO's new learning center.

8 PLEASANT HILL MONUMENT

Erected in 1895 in the heart of Pleasant Hill to "her fallen heroes who died in defense of the Union and who sleep in unknown graves," this monument serves as a memorial to those who go to war and never return.

01 HISTORY & HERITAGE ATTRACTIONS

COVINGTON-NEWBERRY HISTORICAL SOCIETY MUSEUM

Operated by the Covington-Newberry Historical Society, the Museum is located across the street from the J.R. Clarke Public Library. The building itself dates to about 1850 and has served many tasks for the town, including a schoolhouse, firehouse, village hall, and jail. Museum exhibits include early photographs, military displays, promotional pieces from local merchants and political campaigns, and a collection of antique toys, clothes and kitchen items.

FLETCHER COVERED BRIDGE

Dedicated in 1998, the Fletcher covered bridge is a new look at an old style of bridge design. Visitors to the bridge can get a taste of the simple life while visiting this historic re-creation.

FORT PIQUA PLAZA

Built in 1891, the Fort Piqua Plaza has been an icon of history for over 130 years. This hotel played host to many prominent people including Teddy Roosevelt and William Howard Taft, who both spoke from its balcony during their campaign tours in 1912. This beautiful Late-Victorian style building is now home to the Piqua Public Library and a grand banquet center.

HAYNER DISTILLING EXHIBIT AT TROY HAYNER CULTURAL CENTER

The Troy-Hayner Cultural Center houses the premier United States collection of Hayner Distillery artifacts and ephemera. The collection includes over 100 bottles and jugs spanning more than 56 years of manufacturing with dozens of spirits, products and marketing items. In 1866, Lewis Hayner built a distillery on Water Street in Troy and founded "Lewis Hayner, Distiller, Pure Copper Distilled Rye and Bourbon Whiskies." Hayner Distillery expanded with the country's industrial revolution and fell away with the threat of impending prohibition. The distillery on Water Street was shut down in 1920.

The National Aviation Heritage Area spans an 8-county region in West Central Ohio sharing our nation's aviation heritage at over 15 aviation sites. WACO Air Museum is one of those sites and helps tell the story of early aviation.

OVERFIELD TAVERN MUSEUM

1808 was a time when the small settlement of Troy, Ohio was on the great frontier. The Overfield Tavern was a gathering place for social and government purposes and is now a museum featuring a collection of late-18th to early-19th century artifacts. The two-story Federal style square-hewn log building has survived as the oldest building in Miami County and one of the oldest in Ohio and is on the National Register of Historic Places.

THE RANDOLPH & MCCULLOCH FREEDOM'S STRUGGLE COMPLEX

The Randolph & McCulloch Freedom's Struggle Complex is situated on the north-south corridor of County Rd. 25-A. It was a well-known pathway to fugitives on the Underground Railroad north to Canada. The site along the Great Miami River overlooks the Randolph settlement of Rossville that would have served as a hospitable place for refugees seeking passage north to freedom. In 1846, the arrival of nearly 400 Randolph Freedman came by way of the Miami-Erie Canal where this site would serve as a swing bridge between Lock 9 and the Johnson Farm. Also,

the junction across from the property site is Ohio Route 66 leading north along the travel scape of church spires into Mercer County.

This museum showcases the history, companies, and artifacts relevant to Tipp City and Monroe Township, the Miami and Erie Canal, Chaffee Opera House, and the Society's Oral History Project.

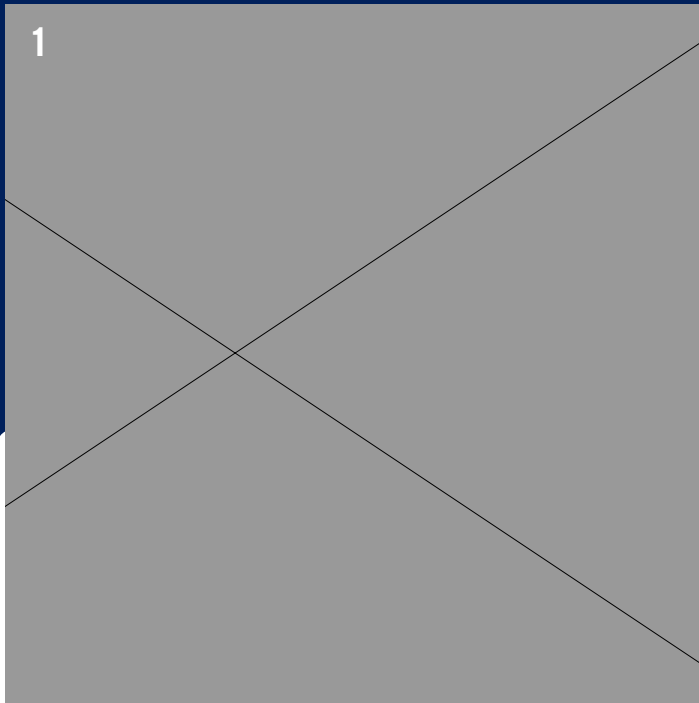

FISHING ON THE GREAT MIAMI & STILLWATER RIVERS



Did you know that Ohio is ranked number ten in the United States for fishing? Access to a large variety of lakes and rivers makes Ohio a great place to fish and Miami County is home to two of those rivers. The Great Miami and The Stillwater rivers, and other small lakes and ponds in Miami County are perfect for fishing.

The Great Miami River is known for smallmouth bass fishing, being number one in the Ohio River System for trophy sized smallmouth bass. It's not just smallmouth bass in the Great Miami, the river is home to over 100 different species of fish. Try your hand at fly fishing, drop your kayak in, or just fish off the shore.

The Stillwater River runs through the West side of Miami County and was designated as Ohio's 8th scenic river in 1975. Like the Great Miami, the Stillwater River is great for smallmouth bass fishing. The river is also home to over 59 fish species and a variety of waterfowl and songbirds like the great blue heron and wood ducks.

Remember to get your Ohio fishing license before your river fishing trip in Miami County. Don't have a license? The Miami County Park District does not require a license when fishing in ponds at parks such as Garbry Big Woods, Maple Ridge Reserve, Twin Arch Reserve, and Stillwater Prairie Reserve.



FARM FRESH

Who doesn't love home grown ingredients and supporting local. There are many ways to find farm fresh produce and other goodies throughout Miami County and farmers markets are a great place to start.

You can find local farmers markets throughout Miami County starting in early summer and into the fall. The **Cherry Street Local Farmers Market** in Downtown Troy features a variety of farmers, growers, and other vendors Saturday from 9am-noon. Thursdays from 3pm-6pm in the heart of Downtown Piqua, you'll find the **Piqua Community Farmers Market**. You can also find monthly or pop-up markets throughout other communities.

Looking for some farm fresh hands on activity for the whole family? Look no further, there are multiple u-pick opportunities throughout the year for you to experience.

Fulton Farms Market has a variety of u-pick options throughout the different seasons. Early summer, pick your own strawberries. Fall, come pick pumpkins straight from the patch. In the winter they even offer u-cut Christmas trees for the Holiday season. Fulton's is also known for their sweet corn so keep an eye out for when corn is available and their annual Sweet Corn Festival. When visiting, check out their market full of locally grown and made produce, sweets, and other goodies.

Frolic among the flower beds and make your own bouquet at **Brown's Triple B Farm**. Choose from over 60 varieties of flowers available throughout the growing season such as sunflowers, zinnias, daisies, dahlias, and more! The farm is open for picking Saturday mornings and Wednesday evenings typically from mid-July to early fall.
